Key Stage 2 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 90% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 90% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in GPS was 90% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in Maths was 90% which was in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above combined was 90% which was above the national average

Key Stage 1 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 82% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 82% which was above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 82% which was above the national average

Year 1 Phonics Attainment

EYFS Attainment

- The percentage of pupils with entitlement to FSM achieving a good level of development was above the national average at 86% compared with 52% nationally
